"Budgeted last year" is as passed in the original budget and does not reflect changes approved by the board for expenditure after the budget was passed. The budget also includes a planned \$1 per hour raise for all staff employed as of July 1, based upon performance evaluations, for the 2025-2026 program year. WIOA Adult/Dislocated Worker includes funds from both programs as money may be transferred between programs. Also included are two positions funded with special grant funds. Audit cost increased due to additional requirements contained in agreement with FloridaCommerce and required of all local boards. "Other Contractual Services" increase reflects agreement with CareerSource Gulf Coast for shared WIOA coordinator.
